Fresno State Programs for Children (PFC)

is responsible for all campus-affiliated children's programs, providing early care and education that strive to ensure the optimal development of each child enrolled. Programs for Children, Inc. provides services to the children of the California State University, Fresno student body and, to a limited extent, to faculty, staff, and the larger community.

Primarily funded by the State Department of Education, Programs for Children, Inc. is committed to giving priority to student families who meet state eligibility requirements. Secondary funding is provided through parent fees, student body fees, campus department funds, and Federal Grant and Contract funds.

The Board of Directors for Fresno State Programs for Children includes the Executive Director and ten appointed university, community, and student representatives. The board meets monthly and is responsible for all aspects of the program, including policies and procedures for the program and its employees, budget, salaries, administration, and services. All meetings are open to parents and other interested parties.

PFC operates three child care centers at California State University, Fresno. Management and accounting services are provided by the Association pursuant to a management services agreement.

The **Infant/Toddler Program** provides care for children aged 3 months to 2 years. Caregiving routines are opportunities to build a one-on-one relationship between teachers and each child.

The **Preschool Program** provides care for children ages 3 to 6. Children attending kindergarten enroll in preschool classrooms during the school year. During the summer, they are enrolled in the School Age Program. The Preschool Program also offers an extended day service.

The **School Age Program** provides care for children ages 5 to 12. The School Age Program also offers an extended day service.
