## What students are saying...

- About their advisors or advising:
- "She listens, she's a good listener which I think is very important in that role. ...she listens, she doesn't just hear."
- On receiving an early alert flag:
- "Well it made me feel like, okay they really care about what I'm doing. They want me to go ahead and get my stuff together."

## Collaboration across decentralized advising centers & campus

- -Advisors were brought to the table from the start
- -Trainings, webinars, monthly meeting check ins
- -Tracking major changes opened communication
- -Creation of Advising Toolbox with note template added uniformity to advisor reports and provided guiding questions to use during advising sessions
- -Progress Report requests received by faculty
- -OIE assists with pulling necessary data and reports for treatment/control students
- -My Degree Plan tool being used with all participants

## What advisors are saying...

- On MyDegreePlan:
- One huge benefit is that he can kind of **get a visual** on what he's going to take every semester and see when he'd be done.
- On student engagement during advising sessions:
- "Another issue is that students are not used to having that much relaxed freedom and conversation when they meet with us so the iPASS students we are meeting with, some of them really like thrived off of that and were like oh yeah this is really helpful and this is really unique"
