

Programs to meet basic needs and support student success

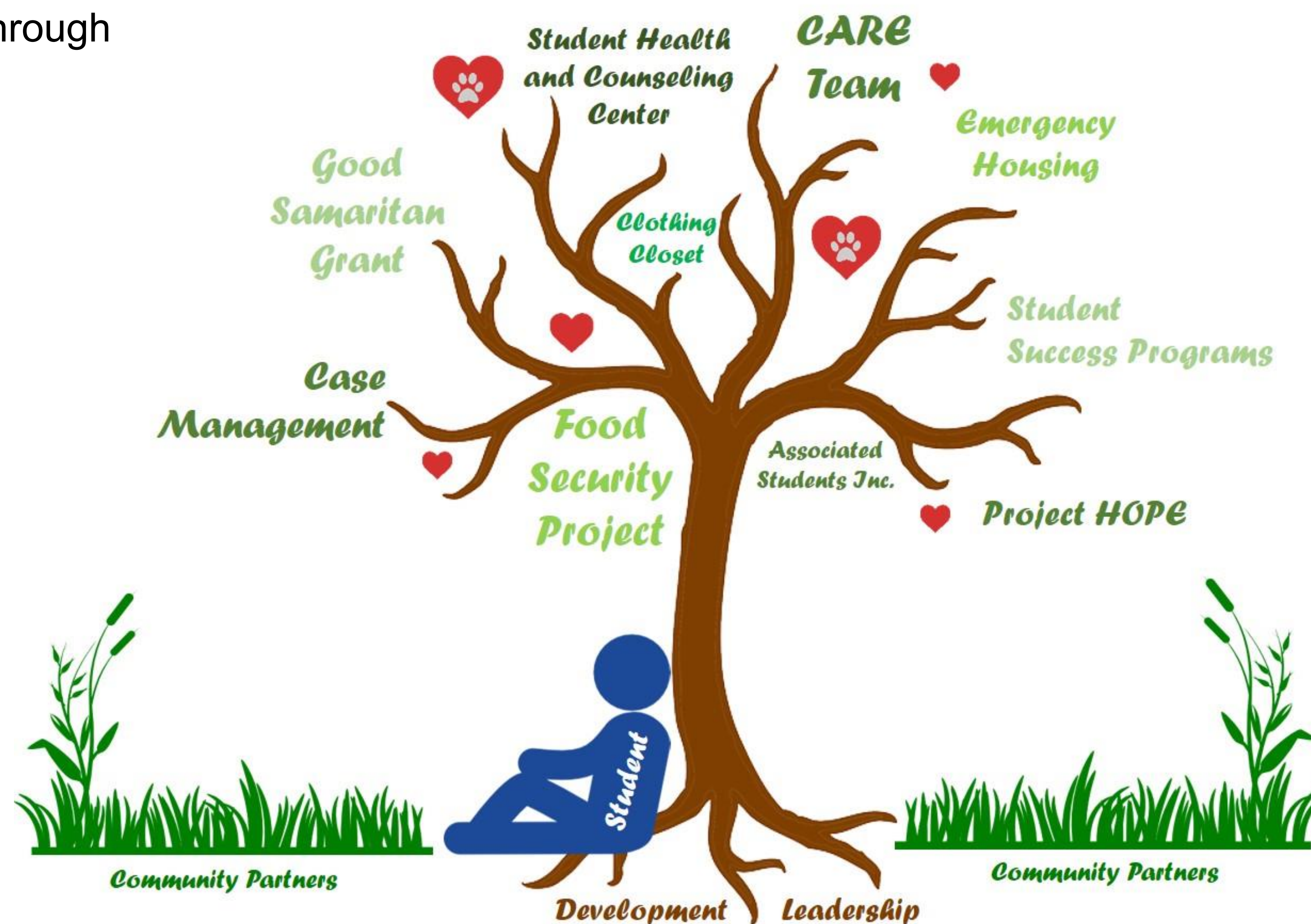
Food Security Project

- Student Cupboard: free food and hygiene pantry for current Fresno State students
- Education and Resources: access to on and off campus resources, CalFresh application assistance, education on healthy eating, budgeting and other life skills
- Catered Cupboard: be our “after event guest” at catered events on campus through the Fresno State Mobile app
- Swipe Out Hunger: meal certificates donated by students for students in immediate food need

Clinical Case Management

- Mental health services and referrals through an integrated care model
- Good Samaritan Grant: emergency funding for unanticipated financial roadblocks
- Project HOPE: Health Opportunity Prosperity Education (HOPE)

Healthy working relationships and collaboration helped build a robust service delivery for our students



Emergency Housing

- Temporary housing is provided for 7-14 days
- Supported by case manager during their stay to assist in securing future housing

Highlights

- Student Cupboard has served over 10,700 unique students in over 124,000 visits since opening in November 2014
- Good Samaritan Grant funded over \$23,000 to 22 students in 2017
- Food Security Project and Good Samaritan Grant is 100% donor funded

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
