What is Think About It?

In support of Title IX, the federal law that prohibits sex discrimination, the California State University system requires all campuses to implement preventive education programs to promote the awareness of Sexual Harassment, Sexual Misconduct, Dating and Domestic Violence, and Stalking.

Fresno State elected to provide this training in an online format, contracting with:



There are **three different courses** offered:

- ✓ New Undergraduate Students
- ✓ New Graduate Students
- ✓ Continuing Students

Each course is different, and provides unique scenarios and interactive content for the targeted audience.



The majority of students completing the course were Continuing Students:

94% completion rate for continuing students

6%* reported having unwanted sex while drunk or using drugs. Alcohol use by either the perpetrator or victim is involved in most sexual assaults.

36%* know someone who has been sexually assaulted.

After completing the Think About It online training course for New Undergraduate Students:

92%* indicated this helped them better understand campus sexual culture.

98%* indicated feeling confident that they'll be able to recognize attitudes condoning sexual violence.

92%* indicated a fuller understanding of what a healthy relationship looks like.

After completing the Think About It online training course for New Graduate Students:

94%* reported feel more confident that they could intervene in a high-risk situation after completing training.

95%* reported the training prepared me to respond to gender misconduct in an academic setting.

95%* reported the training prepared me to respond to intimate partner violence and sexual assault.
