Next, course instructors add to course notes a preview so students know what to expect as far as when the class will meet FTF, Asynchronous, or Synchronous.

What is a hybrid class? At it's most basic "hybrid" means that something is not all one or the other. Not all zebra or horse. Not all Face to Face or Online Asynchronous course delivery.

Hybrid is a blend of delivery and contact methods intended to give the learner the best of all worlds. This blend includes synchronous (like Zoom) and asynchronous (like reading or watching a video alone) and face to face (in a classroom).
