



Colleagues:

We write today to inform you of two issues that will temporarily impact the Professional Human Services (PHS) building.

Beginning February 27, the Central Utility Plant Replacement (CUPR) project safety [fence](#) near the PHS building will be extended impacting access to the building east entry through Friday, March 17. All other entry doors will remain accessible, and directional signage will be in place for pedestrian traffic.

Regretfully, five young [trees](#) on the east side of the PHS building have died and will need to be removed, as recommended by our certified arborist (not related to construction activity). Removal of these trees will take place the week of March 13, and will not impact access to buildings or paths of travel. Please note there may be some noise associated with the removal. The Arboretum Committee will work with our Facilities grounds department to plant replacement trees.
