As a follow up to my October 19 campus communication about the delay of heating for buildings, please be advised of the following update.

Unfortunately, construction activities associated with the [Central Utility Plant Replacement \(CUPR\) project](#) required the delay of turning on our campus boilers (building heating) to allow the contractor to complete the necessary piping work in the building mechanical rooms. Where possible, we are trying to provide heating in some buildings. However, turning on our large boilers is a gradual process. Heating will be on for most buildings by Monday, November 7.

We apologize for any inconvenience the cooler indoor temperatures may cause, and encourage you to consider wearing warm clothing this week. (Please note individual electric heaters are not permitted due to safety concerns.)
