



Dear Colleagues:

As part of the Central Utility Plant Replacement (CUPR) project, new safety fences will be installed Monday, November 21 that will result in the closure of the Maple Avenue Roundabout. Please read the information below for further details.

Impacts:

- The [Maple Avenue roundabout](#) will be closed to all vehicular traffic through January 15, 2023.
- Alternative ADA parking stalls will be available in lot P4 (by Joyal Administration).
- The V-Line bus pick-up and drop-off area will be temporarily relocated to the FAX [bus stop](#) on Shaw Avenue and Maple Avenue.
- The sidewalk from Maple Avenue to Joyal Administration will remain open on the east side of the roundabout.
- An additional [pedestrian pathway](#) between Music and Joyal Administration will be available.
