



Dear Colleagues:

As part of the Central Utility Plant Replacement (CUPR) project, a contractor will be working South of Science II beginning the week of November 14 and will remain in place through Spring 2023. Please find a graphic representation of the impacted area, boxed in red, [here](#).

Impacts:

- There may be intermittent noise and vibration disruptions from jackhammering.
- San Ramon Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic. There will be detour signage indicating alternate traffic routes.
- There will be signage guiding the path of travel along the sidewalk south of Science II and north of Science 1.
