



## Dear Colleagues:

We have heard your feedback about the new LED lighting in the Peters Business Building and the inconvenience associated when the sensors power off the lights after a 10-minute duration despite movement in rooms. We have continued to share this feedback with the contractor and indicated the disruption to office hours and instruction has been affecting occupants.

As of last week, the contractor completed adjustments to the lighting in Peters so that motion-detection sensitivity is enhanced. This means sensors should detect more minimal movement so that lights remain on while you are working and instructing. While it is important that we continue to provide energy-sustainable upgrades for our campus, we hope this adjustment will meet your needs.
