



Dear Campus Community,

The Central Utility Plant Replacement (CUPR) project continues to progress. We recognize how intrusive this project is for our campus community, and we appreciate your patience and support as we help transform our campus for future growth and sustainability.

Beginning February 28 through April, pedestrian and vehicular traffic near the Industrial Technology (IT) Building will be impacted, as outlined in the map [here](#) and as explained below:

- Pedestrian access to the [Amendola Family Student Cupboard](#) will not be available from Lot P21. Access will be available using the sidewalks off Jackson Avenue and Barstow Avenue. (Look for the directional signs to guide you to the main entrance.) Five (5) temporary 30-minute Student Cupboard parking stalls will be provided in Lot P20.
- Vehicular traffic along [Jackson Avenue](#) (between Industrial Technology and the Facilities Management yard) will be limited to one (1) lane. Please allow for extra time and slower speed as you drive through this area.
- A section of Lot [P21](#) (near the IT building) will be closed to all vehicles. Additional faculty and staff parking will be available in Lot P20; ADA faculty and staff parking will be [available](#) in Lots P23 and P24.

Pedestrian access to all classrooms, departments and related offices in the IT buildings will remain open, and will be redirected with directional signage, as needed.
