## Dear Campus Community,

As shared in our [May 6th](#) email to the campus community, safety fencing has been installed in several areas throughout campus as part of the Central Utility Plant Replacement (CUPR) Project.

To further ensure the safety of pedestrians in these areas, the fencing barriers on the west side of campus (by the Library and McKee Fisk) will be modified to **exclude** pedestrian and ADA pathways. This additional space within the fencing will ensure that we have a compliant fire lane as well as access for first responders. This area will primarily be used for construction traffic.

The modified fencing plan is shown in red [here](#) and will remain in place until early next year. Access to the buildings in this area of campus will be available, using alternative entries that will be clearly delineated with appropriate signage. Pedestrian and ADA path of travel are indicated in [blue](#). If anyone requires special accessibility accommodations, please contact Services for Students with Disabilities or Human Resources/ADA Coordinator.

Please exercise caution and plan for additional time as you walk across campus. There may be some slight delays as pedestrian traffic may need to be paused by construction workers to allow for construction vehicles to pass within the fenced areas.
