Each lactation room is designed for single occupancy to ensure privacy and comfort and is equipped with a comfortable chair, an attached side table, and access to electrical outlets to support breast pumps.

Nursing mothers are responsible for bringing sealed containers and arranging for proper milk storage.

Rooms are available on a first-come, first-served basis to all faculty, staff, and students.
