Motorcycle Patrol

Enforcement

Motorcycles will be used as an alternate mean of transportation for officers. They allow officers to maneuver through traffic to respond to calls quicker and get to places a patrol vehicle cannot go. The use of motorcycles will allow Fresno State police officers to focus on

- cross walk enforcement
- vehicles who roll through stop signs
- cell phone use
- distracted driving
- community contacts

The motorcycles are electric which allow officers to arrive on scene without disruption and may allow them to come across a crime in progress without being detected.



About the Motorcycles

The electric motorcycles were purchased through a grant from the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District. These motorcycles put off zero emissions, which means they can travel anywhere, even indoors.

The motorcycles will be stored in a trailer that will have the capabilities to charge and transport motorcycles.

About the Officers

Officer Manucharyan, Officer Bergman and Officer Gaxiola completed an 80 hour course through P.O.S.T. put on by the Fresno Police Department. This extensive training prepares officers to use their motorcycle as a tool for enforcement.

Motor Officer Gaxiola had previously been certified when he worked for Kerman Police Department. This was the first time going through the training for Officer Manucharyan and Officer Bergman.
