

Outcomes

- 49 courses implemented (as of Spring 2014) and 13 more courses in AY 2014-2015
- 14 new service-learning courses implemented
- 100+ faculty training and instructional support through Teaching Innovation Summer Academy
- 750+ unique faculty and staff participated in workshops
- 30,000 students impacted in redesigned courses
- Overall increase in course grades and pass rates
- 2,156 students "saved"
- Intuitional impact for DISCOVERe, APLU, CSALT, TILT, and Student Learning Technology

- Intuitional impact for Advising Training Portal, Career Development Course, Financial Wellness Program, Pre-Nursing Initiative, and new campus staff
