

Put sign boards indicating the direction of buildings on all forks, entrances, exits and circles.

CURRENT CHALLENGE:

My idea is to improve the directions to reach buildings in Fresno State. When I first came to Fresno State, I had a hard time finding the buildings thus, was often late for classes. For a newbie, campus map gives too much information at one place which is again hard to articulate. I have also tried putting the name of building in Google Maps but it does not have the information about many of them. I have been on campus for quite some time now but till today if I need to find a new building, I struggle to get to the right one. Since the campus is widespread and has various buildings with multiple entrances and exits, it is a challenge to come out of one building through a specific exit and find the exact entrance of the next one.

PROPOSED SOLUTION:

My suggestion is to put sign boards indicating the direction of buildings on all the forks, entrances, exits and circles. For example, if I am at Joyal and want to go to Mc Fisk and I came out from the front door of Joyal then I should have a signboard indicating the direction of Mc Fisk. I will move further in that direction and should get another signboard near the fountain indicating direction. The next one should take me to the right from library and finally outside Mc Fisk. I would also suggest tagging the names of buildings in Google Maps.

BENEFITS TO FRESNO STATE:

This solution will hugely support the students, save them time and add to the physical infrastructure of Fresno State. Adding a feature like above will not only improve the look and feel of campus but also add an extra feature in Fresno State diaries.
