Annual Regulated Equipment and Tools Report - 2024

In July of 2022, the CSU Board of Trustees approved a system-wide Regulated Equipment and Tools policy as recommended by the CSU Police Chiefs. This policy (706) was adopted and published as outlined by Assembly Bill 481 and requires every law enforcement agency in the State of California to publish certain information annually regarding specified equipment.

Of the 16 regulated types of equipment and tools outlined in Assembly Bill 481, Fresno State Police Department (FSPD) only maintains one mobile communications trailer that meets the definition of a "command and control vehicle". Information regarding the use, policy compliance, funding, and inventory for the 2024 calendar year (year to date) are outlined below:

Summary of how regulated equipment and tools were used, and the purpose of its use:

• FSPD utilized the mobile communications trailer at all home football games to coordinate public safety operations. FSPD did not have any cases involving the use of any of the other listed equipment included in AB 481.

Summary of any complaints or concerns received concerning regulated equipment and tools:

• FSPD did not receive any complaints or concerns regarding the use of any of the listed equipment included in AB 481.

Results of any internal audits, any information about violations of the regulated equipment and tools policy, and any actions taken in response:

• FSPD did not receive any audit findings or information about violations associated with the regulated equipment and tools policy.

Annual cost and source of funds for regulated equipment and tools:

• Total expenditures in 2024 for planned purchases to support training and/or readiness of the listed equipment included in AB 481 is about \$3,400. These expenditures came from the Public Safety general fund.

Current inventory of regulated equipment and tools:

• FSPD has one self-contained command post trailer including specialized command, control, and communications equipment.

Planned purchases of regulated equipment and tools in AB 481:

• FSPD has no plans of purchasing any equipment listed in AB 481.



To further our efforts towards transparency and to provide an opportunity for communication, FSPD will be hosting a campus forum where we will discuss the information contained within this annual report. The forum will be held on December 6, 2024 at 2pm in the Library, Room 2108. The campus forum is open to all students, faculty, and staff at Fresno State.
